

# Community Fund Awards 2009

## Terms and Conditions

1. These terms and conditions are the Rules (“Rules”) which apply to Premier Power Community Fund Awards (“Awards”) only, unless otherwise expressly stated. By applying, applicants agree to be bound by these Rules.
2. The Community Fund Awards 2009 is organised by Premier Power Ltd having a trading address at Ballylumford Power Station, Islandmagee, Larne, Co Antrim, BT40 3RS (“Premier Power”).
3. Premier Power reserves the right to cancel or amend the Community Fund Awards, and these Rules at any time without prior notice.
4. In the event of a dispute, the decision of Premier Power shall be final and no correspondence or discussion shall be entered into.

## Qualifying Entrants

- 5 To qualify to apply for the “Premier Power Community Fund Awards 2009” you must be resident in the Larne Borough Council area.
6. Employees of Premier Power or any company contractually involved with Premier Power or any such person’s subsidiary or associated companies, agents or members of their families or households, are not eligible to apply for the Awards. Premier Power reserves the right to verify the eligibility of all applicants.
- 7 By submitting an application, you hereby warrant that all information submitted by you is true, current and complete.
8. Premier Power reserves the right to disqualify any applicant if it has reasonable grounds to believe the applicant has breached any of these terms and conditions.
9. If an applicant is disqualified from the Award, Premier Power in its sole discretion may decide whether a replacement applicant should be selected. In this event, any further applicant will be selected on the same criteria as the original applicant and will be subject to these Rules.

## Award Entries

10. Only one entry per legal person (*e.g.*, individual, organisation, group or company) per Award is allowed.
11. Proposals will be accepted from all aspects of community life – economic, social, educational, and cultural. However, preference will be given to proposals with a focus on helping older people.
12. All applications must be submitted on an official application form. Application forms are available from Barbara Stevenson, Premier Power Ltd having a trading address at Ballylumford Power Station, Islandmagee, Larne, Co Antrim, BT40 3RS or via the Premier Power website [www.premier-power.co.uk](http://www.premier-power.co.uk). Failure to do so will disqualify the entry.
13. The Closing Date for receipt of completed applications is September 28<sup>th</sup>, 2009. Applications received after this date will not be considered. Each application will be assessed by a panel of judges made up of Premier Power personnel or external judges selected by Premier Power. This assessment will take place within 4 weeks of the closing date for receipt of entries. **It is essential that the contact person nominated in the application is available during this period to clarify points raised in the application.**
14. Proof of posting cannot be accepted as proof of delivery.

## Awards

15. Award winners' will be contacted on or before October 27th, 2009.
16. In all matters, the decision of the judge(s) and Premier Power shall be final and no correspondence or discussion shall be entered into.
17. Three awards of £2,500 each will be distributed.
18. An amount awarded will be paid by cheque to the successful applicant by Premier Power. The successful applicant may be required to provide progress reports and updates on their specified project.
19. Awards are made at Premier Power's discretion and no awards will be made as a result of improper actions by or on behalf of any applicant.

## **Intellectual Property Rights**

20. You hereby warrant that the information which you submit and/or distribute will not infringe the intellectual property, privacy or any other rights of any third party, and will not contain anything which is libellous, defamatory, obscene, indecent, harassing or threatening. If relevant, Premier Power reserves the right, but not the obligation, to screen, filter and/or monitor information provided by you and to edit, refuse to distribute or remove the same.

## **Liability**

21. Premier Power does not accept any responsibility for any damage, loss, injury or disappointment suffered by any applicant entering the Community Fund Award Scheme or as a result of accepting any award.

## **Data Protection and Publicity**

22. Winners may be requested to take part in public relations activity and Premier Power reserves the right to use the names and addresses of winners, their photographs and audio and/or visual recordings of them in any publicity.

23. Any personal data relating to applicant will be used solely in accordance with current data protection legislation and will not be disclosed to a third party without the individual's prior consent.
